Re: Public Records Act Request

Dear Mr. Fawcett:

In further follow-up to your request dated September 28, 2005, to inspect and make copies of

- (1) Compliance Plan submitted to OSHPD for Palomar Medical Center;
- (2) Request for Extension to Seismic Safety Deadlines submitted to OSHPD for Palomar Medical Center;
- (3) Seismic Evaluation of the McLeod Tower at Palomar Medical Center;
- (4) Reports, Documents, Spreadsheets, Calculations, Analysis, and/or Information used to determine a Structural Performance Category (SPC) for the McLeod Tower at Palomar Medical Center;
- (5) Reports, Documents, Spreadsheets, Calculations, Analysis, and/or Information used to determine estimated cost of upgrading the McLeod Tower at PMC to a level above an SPC-1.

However, we gave notice in our initial response of October 7, 2005 that Palomar Pomerado Health was extending, through October 21, 2005, the period in which to collect the documents and determine what portions, if any, are publicly disclosable.

It has been determined that such documents are publicly disclosable. Therefore these are available for your inspection at Palomar Pomerado Health's ("PPH") offices at 15255 Innovation Drive, San Diego, California 92128-3410. If you desire a copy of all or part of these documents after your inspection, pursuant to California Government Code Section 6253(b), PPH shall make such copies for you in accordance with the law and PPH's policy at 10 cents (\$0.10) per page for standard reproduction of documents 8 1/2" x 14" or less, and actual costs for reproduction of oversized documents or documents which require special processing. Clerical costs directly incurred in duplication, billed at \$16.00 per hour, pro-rated as appropriate, which covers the direct cost of duplication, would also be charged.
